



SENATE BILL 09-108 VEHICLE REGISTRATION FEE INCREASE & LATE FEE PENALTY



Effective June 1, 2009

This legislation requires Colorado motor vehicle owners to pay a late fee on delinquent registrations. This late fee will be assessed at \$25 per month up to \$100.

The late fee will apply to:

- Renewals past the 30 day grace period
- Expired temporary permits
- New vehicles not registered within 60 days of purchase
- Vehicles not registered within 90 days of residency in Colorado

State law requires vehicles to be currently registered whether used or not.

Effective July 1, 2009

*Senate Bill 09-108 will increase fees each year through June 30, 2012
Fees are based on weight of the vehicle/trailer*

Vehicle/Trailer	FY09-10	FY10-11	FY11-12+
2,000# & under	\$22.50	\$25.75 (increase of \$3.25)	\$29.00 (increase of \$3.25)
2,001 – 5,000#	\$32.00	\$36.50 (increase of \$4.50)	\$41.00 (increase of \$4.50)
5,001 – 10,000#	\$39.50	\$45.25 (increase of \$5.75)	\$51.00 (increase of \$5.75)
10,000 - 16,000#	\$51.50	\$58.75 (increase of \$7.25)	\$66.00 (increase of \$7.25)
16,001# & over	\$55.00	\$63.00 (increase of \$8.00)	\$71.00 (increase of \$8.00)

Exceptions: Collector plated vehicles (5-yr. registration) are charged the Senate Bill 09-108 add-on fees for one year only & the fee increase for farm trucks/tractors is ½ of the amount listed above. The fees do not apply to vehicles (+50 yrs) with horseless carriage registration. **Additional fees:** House Bill 09-1036 increases the fee for Peace Officers Standards & Training Board from \$.25 to \$.60. Senate Bill 09-002 increases the fee for Emergency Medical Services from \$1 to \$2.
