CONTRACT: Boarding Animals

Animal/Storage Boarding Fees:

Stalls	\$5/day or \$60/month (non-refundable)
Large Steer Pens	\$2/day (up to ten head plus \$0.20 extra for each additional head)
Storage Stall	\$2/day or \$60/month (non-refundable)

Electricity for Tank Heaters:

1500 watt	\$ 2.50/day
1000 watt	\$ 1.75/day
250 watt	\$ 0.50/day
Scale Use	\$10.00/day
\$0.07/KW hour for heat lights.	

Payment is due in advance: Any animal or animals stalled without permission from the Fairgrounds Manager or office staff will be charged \$10.00 per day per animal until proper papers are signed and permission for stalling animals is given.

Stalls shall be cleaned each day. Stalls that need cleaning due to neglect will be cleaned by a Fairgrounds employee. Clean-up fees will be \$5.00. All manure and straw must be moved from the stall to an area designated by the Fairgrounds Manager.

The Fairgrounds Manager reserves the right to inspect stalls and horses or mules on a periodic basis and to call a licensed veterinarian at the owner's expense should any animal appear to be sick or a carrier of any contagious disease. Incoming animals that appear sick will not be admitted without a veterinarian's certificate of health. Any animal that contracts a contagious disease must be moved immediately from the fairgrounds. Diseased animals will be moved at the owner's expense.

- < **No stallions age two (2) as of January 1, current year or older will be allowed to board on the RBC Fairground property. (Example: A colt born July 2, 2007 is considered a 2 year old on January 1, 2009)**
- < Animals must not be changed or removed from their assigned stalls and new animals are not to be stalled without the prior consent of the Fairgrounds Manager.
- < Horses to be stalled in covered stalls only.
- < The track, arena, holding pens and stalls are not available for the use of stall renters on days when scheduled events or facility preparation is in process.
- < No more than three horses per family or individual will be permitted.
- < No more than one horse or mule to any stall, except a mare with foal.
- < The Fairgrounds Manager may move animals in outdoor pens as necessary without prior notification to owner.
- < A duplicate key must be furnished to the Fairgrounds Manager if stalls are locked, for safety purposes for every stall rented.
